It is with considerable disappointment and sadness that we are announcing the cancellation of the Missouri Chamber Music Festival 2020 due to the COVID-19 pandemic. This cancellation includes the following concerts and events:

- **MOCM Morning Music** | June 17, 2020
- **Cantabile Opulence** | June 18, 2020
- **Partita Finale** | June 22, 2020
- **MOCM Adult Chamber Music Intensive** | June 25 - July 2, 2020

I'm sure this comes as no surprise, as organizations in our region and beyond are doing the same. We know this is the only choice to make as, first and foremost, we must do what we can to ensure the health and safety of us all. It is disappointing, nonetheless. This June was to mark the 10th Anniversary of MOCM and we are saddened we will not have the opportunity to celebrate with you as originally planned.


